The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner on the basis that he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.4.

Without even going into the merits of the case and without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, the present petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka as regards his threat perception. It is further directed that if any representation is filed by the petitioner, respondent No.3/Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka would look into the matter and thereafter would take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
