Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 21.12.2015 (Annexure P-2) as submitted by the petitioner.

The record reveals that earlier also the petitioner had approached this Court by way of CRM-M-30513 of 2015 titled 'Rajwinder Kaur vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 16.9.2015, in which, this Court was pleased to pass the following order :-

“Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for seeking directions to police authorities to issue 7 days' prior notice to petitioner in case of registration of any FIR against her.

After arguing for sometime and having failed to convince the Court, learned counsel seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

Learned counsel has very fairly submitted that in the present case the police has already submitted the challan. Once the challan has been presented in the Court, such like representation i.e. (Annexure P-2) dated 21.12.2015 is not maintainable.

Dismissed.
