Reference was received from the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar vide communication dated 28.04.2015 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of their misbehaviour in the Court.

After notice was issued, respondents-contemnners appeared. On 05.02.2016 this Court noticed that the contemnners propose to tender unconditional apology before the Court concerned.

On 16.03.2016 this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the contemnners submitted that the contemnners will appear before the same Court where the incident happened and will tender their unconditional apology in Court alongwith their affidavits.

Adjourned to 28.04.2016.

If the needful is done, the Officer concerned will send report to this Court before the date fixed.”

In terms of the aforesaid order, communication has been received from the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar, wherein it has been stated that the contemnors-respondents appeared before the Court below and submitted their unconditional apology alongwith the affidavits.

Considering the fact that the respondents are apologetic for their conduct and have assured to be careful in future, contempt proceedings initiated against them, are dropped.

Reference stands disposed of.
