Petitioner has been in custody for the last more than two years for having been found in possession of 70 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride.

Taking into consideration the quantity of the intoxicating powder i.e. 70 grams and the duration of the custody of the petitioner as under trial and out of eight prosecution witnesses only one witness having been examined, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to a condition that petitioner will not commit the similar offence of which he is accused of during the period of trial. In case of any such eventuality, it will be open to the prosecution agency to approach this Court again for cancellation of bail.
