ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 423 dated 08.08.2015 registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh under Sections 304-B, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the statement given by the Medical Officer. He contends that the petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2015 and he is the husband of the deceased. He further states that the marriage took place in 2008 and the incident is of August 2015 and there were no injuries on the body and the postmortem report does not indicate the cause of death and the FSL report had also been received and there was no poison and now doctor has been examined and according to her the death was not unnatural and it was a natural death and some yellow brownish fluid was found in the trachea.

The postmortem report does not refer to any injuries. No poison was found. The Medical Officer has been examined. In her opinion the death was not unnatural.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
