The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. December 30, 2015.

The petitioner as member of unlawful assembly had joined hands with Sukhinder Singh and others in inflicting injuries on the head of Gurmeet Singh and complainant Satnam Singh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner.

I have gone through the police file which also indicates that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. Co-accused of petitioner

Lakhwinder Singh and Pritam Singh have been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail by this Court. It is a cross-version case against injured Gurmeet Singh for having abducted Ramandeep Kaur, cousin sister of the petitioner.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, taking into consideration the role attributed to the petitioner and the period of detention suffered by him, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/ Duty Magistrate, Moga subject to an additional condition that before release of the petitioner he will be required to furnish an affidavit to the effect that he will not tamper with the evidence and will not indulge in the similar activity during the pendency of the trial. In case of violation of the above said conditions, it will be open to the prosecution agency or the complainant to seek cancellation of bail.
