Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the State has produced the statements of petitioner No.1-Khushi @ Ruksar, as well as petitioner No.2-Rajinder Kumar, wherein, they have stated that they do not have any threat to their life and liberty from the other side and do not need any police protection. Similar statement of respondent No.4-Noor Din, who is father of the petitioner No.1-girl, was also

recorded to the effect that he has no objection to the matrimonial alliance. Statements of both the petitioners as well respondent No.4 produced in Court today, are taken on record.

Without commenting upon the validity of marriage and taking into consideration the statements made by petitioners No.1 & 2 as well respondent No.4, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
