ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition is for quashing of criminal complaint No.COMI/231/2014 dated 29.05.2013 titled as Gurpreet Kaur Versus Sudeep Singh and others, the summoning order dated 16.08.2014 and all the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of written compromise arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the trial Court after statements of the parties were recorded regarding the compromise. The trial Court has reported that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence. The trial Court has also sent the statements of parties.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the complaint pending.

In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the

principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid complaint, summoning order and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed qua the petitioner.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
