FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 05.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dasuya has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Parminder Singh as well as of complainant Rupinder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure property dispute over legacy and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.119 dated 05.09.2011 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 511, 120-B IPC, Police Station, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
