FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner Satbir in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.309 dated 21.09.2015 registered at Police Station Chandhuth, District Palwal under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 302, 34 IPC, are that he along with his accomplice numbering 4/5 had assaulted deceased Abhishek.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor any role is attributed to him in a specific manner and that similarly placed co-accused Rahul has been granted regular bail vide orders of this Court dated 17.10.2016.

The factual scenario could not be controverted by learned State counsel. Thus, in view of the principle of parity together with the fact that there is no specific attribution to the petitioner and he is in

custody since 28.10.2015 together with the fact that the trial will take a long time to conclude, impels this Court to allow the prayer made. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Palwal.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
