Petitioner, no doubt, has joined investigation but in view of the fact that he as a member of unlawful assembly, armed with sword, danda, had trespassed in the house of the complainant and assaulted the complainant, but no extraordinary exceptional circumstances exist to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, especially, when the petitioner has been attributed a grievous injury with danda on the person of complainant while he was lying on the ground.

The petition is dismissed, without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to seek concession of regular bail. Interim order stands vacated.

It will be appreciated if, the application for regular bail is decided expeditiously.
