The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.176 dated 25.11.2014 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, B Division, District Amritsar.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 90 grams of intoxicating powder.

Upon report of the Chemical Examiner having been received, the same has been found to be containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as commercial in nature.

In view of the above, prayer made by the petitioner for grant of regular bail, is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
