Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 29.7.2015 under Sections 307,336, 325,323,148,149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act,PS Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

It is contended that for the solitary absence of the petitioner on 25.2.2016 on account of marriage of his cousin sister (daughter of his mama),his bail was cancelled and nonailable warrants were issued.

Vide order dated 16.3.2016 while issuing notice of motion, petitioner, on surrendering before the trial court within 7 days, was directed to be released on interim bail.

At the time of hearing,learned counsel submits that

pursuant to the said order petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and was released on interim bail.

The said factual position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court pursuant to the order dated 16.3.2016 passed by this court, is made absolute.
