Petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of ASI Gurmeet Singh on the basis of secret information alleging that petitioner alongwith Ranjit Singh and others had formed a gang and they used to snatch vehicles and prepare forged papers besides indulging in selling of intoxicants.

Petitioner is not specifically named in the FIR, however, he was involved in the case on the basis of the disclosure statement of his co-accused. Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. September 4, 2015. Challan

stands already presented; and co-accused of the petitioner have been granted concession of bail. On the principle of parity, petitioner can also be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is clarified that the petitioner has been granted bail subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity. In case of his involvement in similar case, the present order will be deemed to have been cancelled.
