Present application is the second application seeking pre-arrest bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.36 dated 19.3.2015 under Sections 420 IPC, PS Daresi, Ludhiana, Distt. Ludhiana.

The change of circumstances is the alleged compromise dated 9.2.2016(P-2) entered upon with the complainant.

Learned State counsel on instructions concedes that compromise has been effected and the amount in question has been returned to the complainant. It is further not dispute that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of order dated 16.3.2016 passed by this Court and petitioner's custodial interrogation is no longer required.

For the reasons stated above, interim bail granted vide order dated 16.3.2016 is made absolute.
