Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.32 dated 22.01.2015, registered under Sections 302, 498-A, 34 IPC, Police Station Pataudi, District Gurgaon.

State counsel states that petitioner no.2 is not the husband but the brother-in-law. She also states that petitioner no.1 has not joined the investigation in compliance of order of this Court dated 16.03.2016. State counsel also informs that the husband, father in law and mother in law had been convicted vide judgment dated 21.12.2015 and the petitioners could not be arrested.

The petitioners have been evading their arrest from the very beginning. Proceedings have started to declare them proclaimed offenders. No ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
