Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.171 dated 23.08.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala.

As per prosecution Version, an alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 1020 tablets.

Report of the Chemical Examiner having been received, the same has been found to be containing the salt of Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride.

State counsel would inform the Court that the same is 83.64 grams of the salt in question.

The same would be construed as commercial quantity.

Under such circumstances, prayer made in the present petition for grant of bail is declined.

Petition dismissed.
