Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.687 dated 01.11.2015, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), registered with Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar (**Annexure P-1**).

The petitioner was nominated as an accused in a complaint case filed by complainant Raj Kumar under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 on 30.11.2011 for dishonoured cheques amounting to Rs.2 lacs. Due to petitioner's non-appearance, he was declared proclaimed offender on 11.03.2013 and the aforesaid FIR was also lodged under Section 164-A, IPC.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the directions passed by this Court on 12.01.2016, the petitioner has deposited a demand draft of Rs.2 Lacs and has also been released on interim bail on 12.02.2016 by the trial Court.

Learned State Counsel does not refute the aforesaid submission.

Learned Counsel for the complainant has also been heard and he is also unable to refute the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial Court in compliance of order dated 12.01.2016 passed by this Court is confirmed.
