The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 5 dated 28.01.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Tarsikka, Amritsar Rural, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded. It is further reported that compromise has been effected between the parties and the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, FIR No. 5 dated 28.01.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Tarsikka, Amritsar Rural, stands
