Defence taken in the written statement is that the petitioners have not completed 10 years of service up till December, 2006 since the claim is for regularisation and therefore they cannot be granted the said benefit.

The grouse of the petitioners is that they have service of over ten years and upto 27 years. However, the dates of joining of the petitioners have not been mentioned in the writ petition and only total years of service have been mentioned. Neither the respondents have passed any specific order.

In such circumstances, it is not possible for this Court to decide whether action of the respondents is justified or not in the case of the petitioners who are 33 in numbers.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass speaking orders in cases of the petitioners after affording them an opportunity of hearing and the same be conveyed to them. Needful be done within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
