The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.230, dated 7.11.2015, registered under Sections
323/324/506/341/148/149/34/326 of the IPC, at Police Station Civil
Lines, Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 17.3.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General Punjab has accepted this factual assertion and has also accepted the other argument that the injury in question was on the little finger of the left hand.

Consequently, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the order dated 17.3.2016 is made absolute, subject to the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
