This is the third bail petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.17 dated 16.1.2015 under sections 20, 21, 29, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act and sections 13 & 14 of Foreigner's Act, registered at Police Station, Sector 5, Panchkula.

Counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that he would not be pressing the instant petition but would make an alternate prayer to expedite trial proceedings.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, who is a lady i.e. w.e.f. 18.2.2015 and coupled with the fact that post investigation and presentation of challan charges were framed on 14.7.2015, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to expedite the trial and in any case conclude the same within a period of four months from today.
