The petitioner has approached this Court seeking a direction to the respondents to release the vehicle lying in the police custody, which is owned by the petitioner.

During the pendency, the report from the Forensic Science Laboratory was sought. The report states that there is apparent tampering on the chassi number of the vehicle and engine number is not available.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no direction can be issued to the authorities to release the vehicle to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
