Present petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner on the ground that he apprehends a threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.5 to 19. Further prayer in the petition is for directing respondents no.2 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case F.I.R No.33 dated 17.2.2016 under sections 447, 323, 427, 457, 380, 365, 148, 149 I.P.C and sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Moga City, District Moga, which has been registered against respondents no.7 to 11 and on the complaint of the present petitioner.

Without going into merits of the case and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, same is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation as regards his apprehension and grievance to respondent no.2 i.e. S.S.P., Moga. In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, respondent no.2 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
