Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Vishal Sharma alias Vishal Pandit in case FIR No. 71, dated 30.08.2014, for offences punishable under Sections 307, 326, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar.

As per allegations, complainant-Manpreet and his friend Navdeep Singh @ Lub were waylaid at 9.10 a.m. on 26.08.2014 by ten named accused persons, accompanied by 5-6 unidentified boys. The accused party is alleged to be fully armed with guns, *gandasas*, *khandas*, *kirpan* etc. The accused party is alleged to have intercepted and thereafter chased the complainant and inflicted six injuries including one opined to be dangerous to life on his person.

The role attributed to the petitioner/accused is that of driving one of the cars used for reaching the place of occurrence and also of striking the motorcycle from the back, resulting to injuries on fall of the

complainant and his friend Navdeep Singh. The petitioner/accused is also alleged to have fired a gun shot of 12 bore rifle which missed towards the complainant.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Ram Lal, points out that six accused persons have been found to be innocent; proclaimed offenders proceedings have been initiated against two accused persons and challan has been presented against the remaining five accused persons.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 09.07.2015.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
