JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Raj Rani in case FIR No.151 dated 29.11.2014, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

It was contended that upon a thorough inquiry by the Incharge, Economic Offence Wing, it was found that the complainant-Mehanga Singh had paid a sum of Rs.6 lacs in 2013 to the main accused-Dr. Rajinder Kumar and his co-accused Inderjit Singh on the pretext of sending the son of the complainant abroad. The petitioner was found to be residing separately from her main accused-husband Dr. Rajinder Kumar and found innocent.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Gyan Singh, concedes the aforesaid factual submissions.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 21.03.2016, is made absolute.
