Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner- Rajbinder Kaur alias Raj Kaur in case FIR No. 214, dated 11.12.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 326/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

On the previous date of hearing on 17.03.2016, the following order was passed:-

“ *Petitioner is a lady who is alleged to have assaulted Waheguru Pal Singh and complainant Gurlal Singh sharing a common intention with her co-accused Nirvair Singh, Jalandhar Singh and Mander Singh. So far as the petitioner is concerned, she allegedly inflicted injuries with a 'khanda type patri' on the left ear of the complainant.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of four days in lodging of the FIR.

The injured had been initially taken to Civil Hospital, Jira from where after

giving first aid he was referred to Amandeep Hospital, Amritsar. All the five injuries on the person of complainant appear to have been declared grievous.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab for 05.04.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on or before 02.04.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, she will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Copy of the MLR of the injured be made available, on the next date of hearing. "

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to aforesaid order dated 17.03.2016, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Balraj Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and further states that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 17.03.2016, is made absolute.

Disposed of.
