FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 05.04.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Surjit Singh, Tarsem Singh, Basant Singh, Harjinder Singh, Amarjit Singh, Balwinder Singh, Ranjit Singh, Avtar Singh, Mangal Singh and Shamsher Singh as well as of complainant Avtar Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a case of version and cross-version whereby offences are not of heinous nature and that the parties have

effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543* and *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052*, DDR No.22, dated 31.03.2011 under Sections 452,323,506,148,149 IPC (subsequently Section 452 IPC deleted) in case FIR No.38 dated 31.03.2011 under Sections 326,323,324,34 IPC (subsequently Section 326 IPC deleted) Police Station, Gharinda, District Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
