Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case complaint case No.1105 dated 30.5.2014 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act,1881, pending in the Court of JMIC,Bathinda.

It was submitted that petitioner has been summoned vide order dated 8.7.2014 to face trial in the aforesaid case, however,as the petitioner is an NRI residing in Canada,he could not appear resulting into issuance of NBWs of arrest for securing his presence for 31.3.2016.

Vide order dated 22.3.2016 while issuing notice of motion, petitioner, on surrendering before the trial court within 10 days, was directed to be released on interim bail.

At the time of hearing,learned counsel submits that pursuant to the said order petitioner has surrendered before the trial

court on 29.3.2016 and was released on interim bail.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court pursuant to the order dated 22.3.2016 passed by this court, is made absolute.
