In FIR No.5 dated 01.03.2016, under Sections 380, 448 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short ('IPC')), registered at Police Station NRI Jalandhar, now, ultimately, the parties have arrived at compromise.

In that view of the matter, on 17.03.2016, this Court had made an order asking the Illaqa Magistrate to record statements regarding compromise. Now, there is a report and the statement by the District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar that the compromise is found to be genuine.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.5 dated 01.03.2016, under Sections 380, 448 IPC, registered at Police Station NRI

Jalandhar along with other consequential proceedings, stands quashed in terms of compromise.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
