On the instructions of ASI Gurnam Singh, State counsel informs that though the petitioner has joined the investigation yet he is not disclosing the source of the poppy husk which was allegedly recovered from the possession of his co-accused Sukhdev Singh. As Sukhdev Singh was arrested from the spot, it is expected that during police remand such an inquiry must have been conducted.

Petitioner having not been arrested from the spot, he can be granted the concession of bail. Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 17.03.2016, is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions that the petitioner will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner and that he will also not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of in the present case.
