The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.8 dated 06.02.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Khamano, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is contended that in pursuance of orders passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further refers to compromise dated 09.02.2016, appended as Annexure P-2, in the bail petition of co-accused Bahadur Singh and Hardeep Kaur, bearing No.CRM-M-8774 of 2016, decided on 05.09.2016, titled as 'Bahadur Singh and another Vs. State of Punjab', wherein, it has been reflected that Bahadur Singh will be responsible to deal with present petitioner, Karan Singh.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents have opposed the instant petition.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have repeatedly

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joined the investigation and co-accused Bahadur Singh and Hardeep Kaur have already been admitted to anticipatory bail by this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.03.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.

However, nothing noticed hereinabove shall be construed as an expression of opinion of this Court, on the merits of the case.
