This is a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

It appears that petitioner No.1 had a matrimonial dispute with respondent No.3.

On asking of the Court, it has been informed that the challan has not been presented in the present case.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

Since challan has not yet been presented, this petition is disposed of with a direction that it will be open to the complainant/any other affected person to approach the investigating officer with supplementary statements. Any supplementary statement voluntarily offered will be taken

into consideration by the investigating officer as per provisions of Section 163 (2) Cr.P.C. It will be open to the investigating agency on the basis of subsequent material gathered to file cancellation report. In the eventuality of filing of cancellation report on the basis of compromise or otherwise, it will be open to the complainant to appear before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate and furnish no objection.
