Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 1.2.2015 on the allegation of having been found in possession of 900 gms. of heroin.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner Jaswinder Kaur, similarly circumstanced, has been granted concession of bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Resham Singh, informs that all the prosecution witnesses stand examined.

The case of the petitioner regarding recovery of commercial quantity of heroin is distinguishable from that of Jaswinder Kaur, a lady. Besides this, taking into consideration the stage of the trial, I do not find any ground to release the petitioner on bail.

Petition is dismissed expecting that the trial may be concluded within two months after the next date of hearing before the trial Court. In

case the trial is not concluded within the said period, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of regular bail.
