Petitioner is alleged to have forged an agreement to sell dated 10.04.2013 regarding the land measuring 669 kanal 2 marla belonging to Janak Lal and others. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of alleged agreement of sale dated 10.04.2013 purported to have been signed/thumb marked by the owners. The petitioner is not alleged to have received any money.

A perusal of the police file and challan indicates that no person appears to have been duped by the petitioner on the basis of alleged agreement of sale. The authenticity of the

agreement dated 10.04.2013 purported to be executed by the original owners will certainly be a debatable issue. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 04.11.2015. The challan has already been presented. Trial is likely to take a long time. The petitioner in such circumstances can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
