It is informed that out of total 29 prosecution witnesses, 20 have been examined. Whether the petitioner is responsible for the homicide of Paramjit Kaur, his wife caused on account of burning, is to be determined during the course of trial. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 21.05.2015. Prosecution agency has been able to produce 20 witnesses out of total 29 witnesses.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that trial Court shall make an earnest endeavour to conclude the entire evidence within a period of four months from the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court. In case the trial is not concluded within a total period of five months after the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
