For having been found in possession of 135 grams intoxicating powder which on analysis was found to be Alprazolam, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 3.11.2015. She was on interim bail for the period spent to await for report of chemical examiner. The co-accused of the petitioner from whom 105 grams of same intoxicating powder was recovered has been granted the concession of regular bail. No doubt, recovery from the petitioner was 135 grams of intoxicating powder, but taking into consideration the circumstance that the recovery is marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed for Alprazolam and the petitioner being a lady, having not misused the concession of interim bail, she can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner will not commit the similar offence of which she is accused of during the entire period of the trial.
