KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 108 dated 03.10.2013 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 66, 66-A & 67 of I.T. Act, at Police Station Budhlada, Distt. Mansa, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate Budhlada, has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It has also been reported that the complainant has no objection if the present FIR registered against the petitioner is quashed. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

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Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, 108 dated 03.10.2013 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 66, 66-A & 67 of I.T. Act, at Police Station Budhlada, Distt. Mansa, stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above the present petition is allowed.
