JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction to the official respondents to investigate the FIR No. 3. dated 20.03.2012, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Ambala or to hand over the investigation to any higher rank officer like Superintendent of Police for taking appropriate action against the accused persons.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though FIR was registered way-back in the month of March, 2012 and representation dated 05.02.2015 (Annexure P-4) has been moved but no action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Director General of State Vigilance Bureau, Haryana, Panchkula to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 05.02.2015 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
