Petitioner seek quashing of FIR No. 47 dated 25.03.2009 under Section 324, 323, 34, 326 IPC registered at Police Station Moga City, District Moga, on the complaint of respondent No. 2, Lakhwinder Singh alleging that on 24.03.2009, the complainant was assaulted by the petitioner and her son. The son of the petitioner has already been acquitted. Now the matter has been compromised with the petitioner.

Parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga. A report has been received to the fact that the matter has been compromised amicably.

Taking into consideration the totality of the circumstances and in view of the full bench judgment in **“Kulwinder Singh and other versus State of Punjab, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, this petition

could be allowed by permitting the parties to compound the matter.

Petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all other criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
