Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Shamsher Singh, submits that statements of petitioner No.1-Ranjita wife of Suraj as well as petitioner No.2-Suraj son of Sh. Ashok Kumar, were recorded, wherein, they stated that they do not have any threat to their life and liberty from the other side. Similar statement of Ashok Kumar, who is the father of petitioner No.2 Suraj, as well as statement of Sunita, who is the mother of petitioner No.2-

Suraj, were also recorded to the effect that they do not have any objection to the matrimonial alliance. The said statements of petitioners No.1 & 2 as well as the statement of Ashok Kumar and Sunita (father and mother of petitioner No.2-Suraj) produced in Court today, are taken on record.

Without commenting upon the validity of marriage and taking into consideration the statement made by petitioners No.1 & 2 as well as the statement of Ashok Kumar and Sunita (father and mother of petitioner No.2-Suraj), no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
