The petitioner was a member of gang which had, on knife and pistol point, robbed complainant Mohmad Niman and his family members. The petitioner has been attributed specific role that she had used knife on wife of brother of the complainant and extorted money, mobile phone and jewellery.

On asking of the Court as to whether the petitioner is involved in any other activity, it has been informed that the petitioner is an accused in another case of dacoity in Delhi in which she has made confessional statement regarding her involvement in the present case also.

It has been informed that the complainant has already been examined in the Court and has identified the petitioner.

In view of the nature of the allegations against the petitioner and her involvement in similar other cases, it will not be appropriate at this juncture of the trial to enter into the niceties of the trial and to determine her culpability. No ground is made out to grant

the concession of bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed. It will be appreciated in case the trial Court finally dispose of the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of four months.
