By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.112, dated 12.06.2013, registered under Sections 379, 427, 148 read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is contended that during the course of investigation, the petitioner has been found innocent and subsequently, on an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C, the petitioner has been summoned to face the trial. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 18.03.2016, the petitioner has appeared and furnished bail/surety bonds before the trial Court. The certified copy of the

order dated 21.03.2016, passed by the trial Court is taken on record.

The learned State counsel has not controverted the above assertion.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 18.03.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
