Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Gurmeet Singh @ Sonu in case FIR No.215 dated 24.10.2011 for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 411, 420, 473 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Basti Jodhewal, Ludhiana (**Annexure P-1**).

The petitioner was apprehended at the spot with a stolen red colour Tavera Car along with other co-accused.

The petitioner is stated to be in the habit of stealing the vehicles and fixing fake number plates and thereafter selling the same.

The petitioner was enlarged on bail vide order dated 07.11.2011 (**Annexure P-2**) and on account of his non-appearance on 11.02.2014, his bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants issued. Due to his continued absence thereafter, he was declared proclaimed offender on 07.06.2014. The petitioner was arrested from his house on 25.12.2015. For his evading the process of law for almost two years, his prayer for regular bail was dismissed by the trial Court.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
