By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.13, dated 09.02.2016, registered under Sections 323, 341, 148, 506, 379 read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station Sigh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 18.03.2016, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. However, the learned State counsel, on instructions states that though the petitioners have joined the investigation, however, they are not cooperating. The recovery of stolen articles is yet to be effected.

Heard.

There is no assistance on behalf of the petitioners. Even on the last date of hearing, none had caused representation on behalf of the petitioners. The Court has perused the entire record with the assistance of learned counsel for the complainant and learned State counsel. Keeping in view the fact that despite repeated opportunities, the petitioners have failed to cooperate in the investigation. The recovery of stolen articles is yet to be effected. There is no progress in the investigation due to uncalled conduct of the petitioners, therefore, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
