The instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7 and further for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.5 to 7 not to harass the petitioners and their family members unnecessarily in order to pressurize petitioner No.2 to sell her property at less price to respondent No.6 and not in accordance with the agreement to sell dated 05.12.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that the representation dated 31.12.2015 (Annexure P-4), given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, by the petitioners be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is directed to look into the said (Annexure P-4); take appropriate action as per law and pass appropriate order within two months after receiving the certificate copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
