Prayer in this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Braham Dev is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 264, dated 14.08.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 307, 332, 353, 186, 379, 188, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal.

As per allegations, petitioner-Braham Dev alongwith Subhash, Ved and 3-4 other boys were intercepted while transporting sand, stole from the banks of Yamuna River. The petitioner is alleged to have tried to run over the police party while driving the tractor and is also alleged to have torn the uniform of SI Kundan Lal while man handling him.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 14.01.2016 and challan has been presented.

Learned State Counsel that apart from the present FIR, the petitioner is involved in another FIR of similar nature and is habitual offender. He further submits that keeping in view the nature and gravity of the alleged offence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
