The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.6 dated 12.01.2016, under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/506/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR in question came to be registered on the complaint of Nirmal Kaur. Allegations against the present petitioner are as regards forging an agreement to sell dated 27.08.2010 pertaining to land under the title and ownership of her husband Sardar Singh, who is stated to have expired on 26.04.2011. It has also been alleged that on the strength of such forged agreement to sell, even a sale deed has been executed after the demise of Sardar Singh.

In the light of such serious allegations, the prayer seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner is declined.

Petition stands dismissed.
