Petitioners were amongst members of unlawful assembly, who armed with deadly weapons and rifles are alleged to have fired shots with rifle on the left thigh of victim Gian Singh on account of previous enmity.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the complainant and the other material witnesses have not supported the case of prosecution.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have been apprised of the statement of the complainant Kewal Singh and eye witness Manjit Singh who appear to have not supported the case of prosecution.

Since the entire challan is not available with this Court to know the material collected regarding the culpability of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to record the statements of all the

prosecution witnesses within a period of two months from the next date of hearing. However, in case the above said direction is not capable of being complied with, within the period of two months from the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court excluding the period of vacation, the trial Court, on expiry of the said period, shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
