By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.98, dated 14.04.2015, registered under Sections 307, 324, 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

It is contended that co-accused, Amrik Singh has already been acquitted by the trial Court on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 18.03.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 18.03.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
